Song Lyrics



Songs with a microphone are easy to sing and highly memorable and therefore suitable for singing in class.

Listen to the song on the CD first to get used to the tune and perform the following activities afterwards to add more challenge and fun to the songs. During the activities it is advisable to turn off the CD as it is difficult to coordinate a class with a pre-recorded track.

Singing activities include:

- Singing in teams with each team singing one line/one word/ two lines/ two words each.
- Singing by leaving one or several specific words out e.g. every time the word “very” comes up the class must remain silent
- Singing in teams and leaving words out at the same time
- Blacken words out whilst the class is singing the song several times until they can sing it from memory



Songs with a set of headphones are sometimes more difficult to sing in class and are therefore more suitable for listening / reading / writing activities. Some of the songs may be perceived as fast in which case it is advisable to provide the students with the lyrics whilst listening to the songs

Listening/Reading /Writing activities include:

- Matching-up exercises
- Find the odd one out
- Write one more verse to the song and perform it in pairs or in front of the class (if they are brave enough)
- Draw a picture of what is described in the song
- Put pictures in the correct order
- Write up a different version of the lyrics and ask your students to spot the mistakes
